1. Column: write down the course's name, title and name of the lecturer and his or her affiliation (department and university).
2. Column: name the course type, i.e. lecture, seminar, tutorial etc.
3. Column: state the weekly number of hours per semester
4. Column: if known, write down the number of credit points according to ECTS; leave empty if unknown.
5. Column: if you received a grade for the course, write it down; for ungraded courses write down 'passed'.
6. Column: not to be filled in by you.
7. Column: give the date written on the certificate issued by the lecturer

In order to document your participation in the individual courses, ask the lecturer for a certificate (Schein). It should contain all the information asked for in the form plus the lecturer's signature. Once you have passed all the courses covering the module 'Courses on Advanced Topics' fill in the above form and bring it along with the respective certificates to the coordination office. We will check your entries, calculate the individual weights and the final grade (if applicable), pass the form on to the person responsible for the module and finally to the examination office.
